

# What do we suggest for your cat?



### Recommended for 1st kitten visit: 8-11 weeks of age

- Wellness Examination
- FVRCP+C vaccination (Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia, and Chlamydia)
- Felv (Feline Leukemia Virus vaccination)
- Triple test- Tests your kitten for Leukemia, Immunodeficiency Virus and Heartworm disease
- Fecal Exam- To check for intestinal parasites
- Dewormer- sent to treat most common parasites that kittens carry

### Recommended for 2nd kitten visit: 12-15 weeks of age

- Wellness Examination
- FVRCP+C vaccination
- Felv vaccination
- Rabies vaccination- 1 year
- Fecal Exam- To check for intestinal parasites
- · Dewormer- sent to treat most common parasites that kittens carry

## Recommended annually for indoor cats

- Wellness Examination
- FVRCP+C vaccination
- Rabies vaccination- 1 or 3 year depending on your pet's vaccine history
- Bloodwork panel- Recommended based on your pet's age to determine the health of internal organs and early detection of disease
- Fecal Exam- To check for intestinal parasites

#### Recommended annually for outdoor cats

- Wellness Examination
- FVRCP+C vaccination
- Felv vaccination
- Triple test
- Bloodwork panel
- Fecal Exam- To check for intestinal parasites
- Dewormer sent to treat common parasites that outdoor cats can carry
